
## Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to implement structured perimeter checks necessary to prevent prisoner escapes, contraband, and unauthorized access by the general public. A schematic drawing of the fence line, compound, detention doors, emergency doors, maintenance doors, and buildings is included to this policy to insure perimeter checks cover all areas.

officer will immediately report the issue to the shift supervisor and write a detailed incident report of his or her findings. The Shift Supervisor will immediately contact the Duty Officer if an issue is serious and/or a security breach is discovered. Each Shift will be informed of the security breach. If it is not an immediate emergency, the Duty Officer will be notified the following workday.

Inclement weather conditions will not be a deterrent to doing a perimeter checks. Staff
will be properly outfitted to conduct the check. It should be noted that in most cases,
inmate escapes occur during inclement weather conditions. If weather conditions
prohibit doing the check at that particular moment, then supervisors may wait until
weather improves. Weather will not be an excuse not to do a perimeter check.
