Wall Related										San Diego	On November 8, 2024, at 5:42 a.m., a National Guardsman operating a Border Patrol Remote Video Surveillance System reported that a small group of suspected noncitizens were scaling the border barrier approximately 25 miles west of the Otay Mesa POE. Agent arrived on scene and observed both men began their descent down the north side of the secondary barrier as the agent exited his vehicle. One of the men, later identified as a citizen of Colombia, fell as he descended, and landed on the north side of the secondary barrier. The second man completed his descent and was subsequently apprehended. The secondary barrier separated the agent from the man; however, the agent approached and observed the man was conscious and moaning in pain. The agent requested EMS at 5:45 a.m. and reported that the injured man was conscious and breathing. A responding agent entered the parking lot at the CEF as the suspect vehicle was exiting. At 9:34 a.m., the suspect accelerated in the parking lot and struck the Border Patrol vehicle as it exited. Agents searched the area but were unable to locate the suspect vehicle. At 2:13 p.m., video operators notified agents that two individuals had climbed over the secondary border barrier near the same location and tracked them as they moved north. The two individuals were observed entering a sedan in the same parking lot as the incident earlier that day. The sedan then exited the CEF parking lot and an agent reported the sedan was the same suspect vehicle that was observed earlier that day. Around 2:18 p.m. an agent reported that he observed a silver Infiniti traveling and that he was initiating a vehicle stop. Then, the pursuing agent reported the suspect vehicle had accelerated to over 100 miles an hour and was pulling away. Seconds later, the suspect vehicle lost control and struck the back of a parked California Department of Transportation truck. The suspect vehicle then struck a guardrail, rolled, and ultimately came to rest upside down near the middle lanes. A BP agent EMT and several other agents responded to the location and assessed the condition of the vehicle's occupants. Two occupants were ejected from the suspect vehicle during the crash. A man, later determined to be the driver, was located on the north shoulder of SR-95 and was conscious. A woman was located 20 feet south of the vehicle with extensive trauma, and another man inside the vehicle who the agents stabilized with a neck brace until EMS arrived. Death in Presence of Immigration Enforcement							1			El Paso	On August 4, 2024, at 12:30 p.m., agents encountered a lone male undocumented noncitizen near Santa Teresa, New Mexico who identified himself as a 21-year-old Guatemalan citizen. The man told the agents he had crossed into the United States from Mexico three days earlier but had become lost. While speaking with the man, the agents noticed that he appeared weak and requested EMS assistance. The agents walked the man to a nearby BP transport bus to cool him in the vehicle's air conditioning and provided him with water while awaiting EMS response. The man's condition was not improving and agents began moving him to another vehicle to transport him to the Santa Teresa Border Patrol Station, where additional cooling methods were available. While agents were assisting the man exit the bus, he became unresponsive, was no longer breathing, and did not have a pulse. Agents began CPR and contacted a Border Patrol radio dispatcher to request the status of the EMS response. After performing CPR for three minutes, the agents placed the man in a BP van requested personnel meet them outside with an automated external defibrillator (AED) and requested that responding EMS be redirected to the station. At 12:50 p.m., the van arrived at the station, where CBP contract medical personnel were waiting with the AED. The AED was applied to the man and the BPAs and contract medical personnel continued performing CPR. At 1:00 p.m., Santa Teresa Fire Department arrived followed by the Sunland Park Fire Department. At 1:15 p.m., responders told agents that the man had a pulse, and they transported him to the Hospitals of Providence Transportation Campus in El Paso, Texas. The agents located the vehicle and attempted to initiate a vehicle stop at 5:10 p.m. but were unsuccessful. The vehicle fled at a high rate of speed and the agents lost sight of the vehicle. They found the vehicle at 5:11 p.m., rolled over on an adjacent road, resting on its side. Agents requested assistance. Texas DPS troopers arrived on scene. Agents and troopers found one occupant, a female citizen of Guatemala, pinned under the vehicle and requested EMS. EMS arrived and transported the woman, who was unconscious but had a pulse. The agents responded to the area and encountered a female undocumented noncitizen. The woman directed them to an area of the desert nearby, where another female noncitizen was in medical distress. The agents requested EMS and determined that she was exhibiting symptoms consistent with dehydration and made efforts to render aid, using water to cool the woman. The agents attempted to give her water, but she was unresponsive and unable to drink. An American Medical Response EMS unit arrived and at 11:06 p.m., transported her to University Medical Center of El Paso. The woman was admitted to the hospital and placed in the ICU. Hospital doctors determined that she was suffering from kidney failure and a blood clotting disorder brought on by severe dehydration. Agents arrived on scene thirty minutes later but did not locate a group of four individuals until 7:51 a.m. Two other members of the group attempted to evade the agents by entering a nearby canal. As agents approached, the two individuals began swimming across the canal and agents reportedly one individual made it across while the other struggled halfway. Agents asked the man to swim back toward them so they could pull him out of the water, but the man did not, and the agents reportedly could not reach him.
