



# KNOW YOUR RIGHTS WITH BORDER PATROL WHEN DRIVING OR WALKING

Remember, if Border Patrol pulls you over when driving or walking **you have rights:**

- You have the right to remain silent.
- You never have to consent to a search of yourself or your belongings, including your vehicle.
- You have the right to film immigration agents, so long as you don't interfere with their actions.
- When in doubt, do not answer questions about your citizenship or immigration status. If you have valid immigration paperwork you can provide them. Never lie or provide false documents.
- Ask if you're free to leave. If yes, calmly and silently do so.
