KNOW YOUR RIGHTS KNOW YOUR RIGHTS KNOW YOUR RIGHTS AT MEDICAL FACILITIES

Remember, anytime you encounter Border Patrol agents at a medical facility **you have rights**:

- You have the right to remain silent.
- Ask if you're free to leave. If yes, calmly and silently do so.
- You have the right to film immigration agents in public spaces, so long as you don't interfere with their actions. If inside a hospital, seek permission from staff.
- When in doubt, do not answer questions about your citizenship or immigration status. If you have valid immigration paperwork you can provide them. Never provide false documents.
- You can refuse to consent to a search of yourself or your belongings.
