 bail, while wealthier accused are released because they can pay fines. Our efforts
 resulted in a first-in-the-nation federal court rulings that Texans are entitled to
 be represented by counsel at bail hearings and that municipal court judges are
 prohibited from jailing people for unpaid fines unless they have access to counsel
 when they enter a plea. When COVID began circulating in Texas prisons and jails in
 early 2020, we spearheaded an effort to educate nearly 500 key criminal justice
 stakeholders in Texas about the risks and mitigation strategies.

The mission of the ACLU Foundation of Texas Inc. (ACLU Foundation) is to advance freedom, dignity and equality for all people, particularly those who have been historically left out of the promise of America due to systemic oppression, disenfranchisement and discrimination.

Form 990, Part III, Line 4d - Other Program Services Description

LGBTQ+ - Our work for LGBTQ equality focused on helping LGBTQ youth obtain equal access to educational opportunities. We represented families in administrative proceedings in school districts across the state to challenge discriminatory policies and practices. We also created know-your-rights resources to help teachers, families, and LGBTQ students advocate for fair policies.

Voting Rights - We successfully settled our lawsuit challenging an attempted voter purge by the Texas Secretary of State. The state created a list of 98,000 alleged noncitizens who were registered to vote, attempting to remove them from the voting rolls. The list included a large number of naturalized citizens who were plainly eligible to vote. As a result of our suit, the state rescinded the list and counties abandoned plans to use it for voter purges. We also represented Crystal Mason, a Black woman who was convicted of illegal voting even though she was unaware the state considered her ineligible to vote and cast a provisional ballot that was not counted. As a member of the Texas Election Protection coalition, we launched the Texas Election Protection campaign to prepare to protect voting rights and facilitate access to the polls for Texans during the 2020 Texas primary and general election.

The Board President, Treasurer, and attorney Board Member initially review Form 990 with the Executive Director and the Finance Manager. The returns are then shared with the entire Board for review prior to filing with the IRS.

Board members sign a conflict of interest form each year disclosing potential conflicts. In addition to signing the disclosure statement, the board also inquires whether any conflicts exist before voting on any matter involving the Foundation's assets.

The Executive Director's compensation is determined by the Board of Directors. The Personnel Committee makes a compensation recommendation to the Board based on an annual salary survey of 53 ACLU affiliates plus a survey of Executive Director salaries of similar organizations in similar locations. The Board then discusses the recommended compensation, deliberates and votes on approval.
